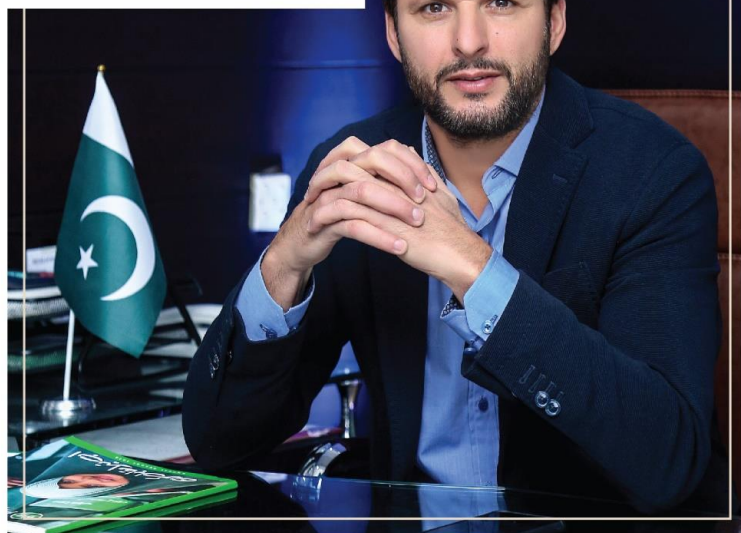
We began 2021 with a new strategic plan, evaluating current progress and keeping a close eye on where we can make further impact.

SAF provides assistance in the areas of Health, Education, Water, Sports & Emergency Relief Response. This quarter we have worked to ensure that children are immunized for Typhoid through MCHPC, bringing access to water by laying down pipelines across Tirah Valley, provided to the sick and vulnerable through SFH, and through our education initiative we are successfully working to reduce the dropout rates (especially for female students), along with creating better opportunities for students returning to school post lock down. These are all relatively modest endeavors which have reaped huge returns for the communities that have been served by our programs.

I hope this report will convey the color and vibrancy of the communities SAF serves, as well as the people of Pakistan.

Thank you for your continued support for SAF and we hope to have your support this upcoming Ramadan, so we can reach more families in need.

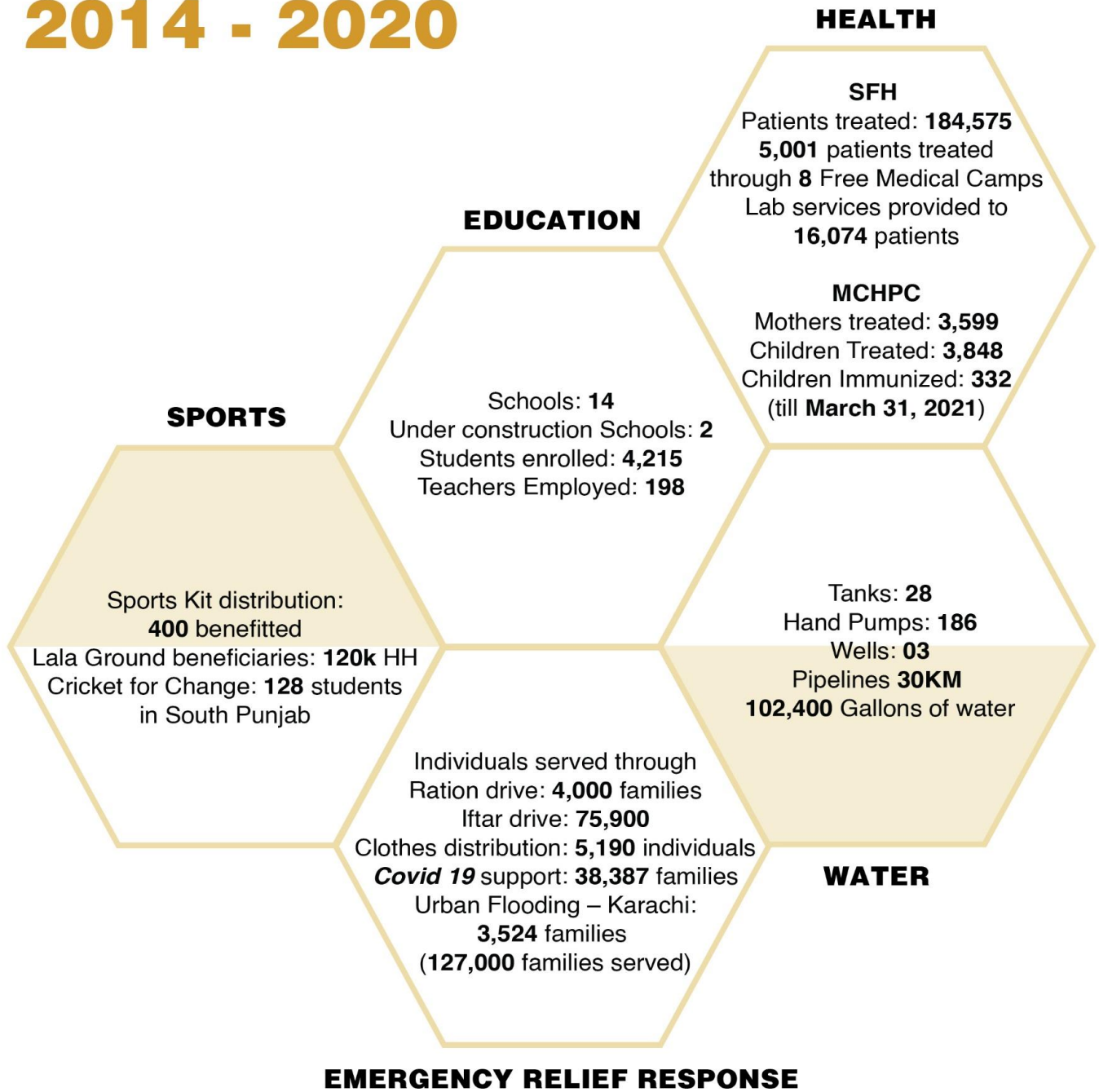

HEALTH

Provision of Medicines:

Accessing medicines in rural remote areas is a bigger challenge than accessing healthcare services. SFH in Tangi Banda, Kohat is providing for on average 100 patients daily, for over 20 adjoining villages. SFH is providing medications for common ailments, diabetes, pediatric pneumonia and nutritional supplements.

Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine:

Furthering access to health care, SAF conducted a week long Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine Immunization Campaign for the community of Malikpur, Lahore through its Mother-Child Health Promotion Center, in collaboration with the Government of Punjab. The objective of the campaign was to vaccinate the surrounding community free of cost, while simultaneously spreading awareness about the disease. SAF school students were also vaccinated via this campaign.



EDUCATION

Bank Bringing Access to Education:

SAF's education vision is a literate Pakistan. To support SAF's mission, Sindh Bank is sponsoring a class of 30 students at a SAF school. The sponsorship of the class will ensure the students have a smooth journey in their crucial years of education.

Bank Al Baraka supports SAF Education:

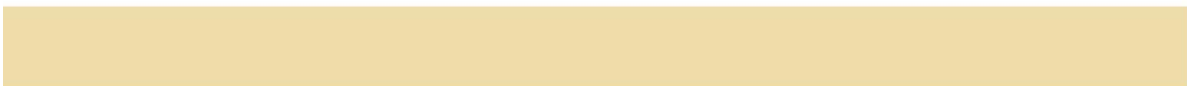
Education is the passport to a bright future. SAF is continuously striving to bring access to education for children living in remote and underserved communities of the country. Bank Al Baraka has continued to support SAF's mission of building futures filled with hope, confidence and dreams.

Mini MBA for Teachers:

Beyond skills, the ability to think critically and creatively is what often separates the most successful from the average. SAF Rehri Goth campus teachers were trained to impart entrepreneurial skills with our partnered organization, Bring Peace Through Prosperity. Trained teachers will train the broader community of Rehri Goth & help them grow and sustain their small businesses.

Second Purpose Built School:

SAF mission is to bring the light of education to every corner of Pakistan. SAF has been donated land to build a school in the remote region of D.G Khan, Punjab. The school construction will be initiated at the end of 2021. The new school will not only offer students long-term benefit, but will also create employment opportunities for families residing in the area.



Calendar 2021 – Stand Still:

Calendar Competition themed “Stand Still” was held across 14 SAF schools, where students created unique artworks to depict their time spent at home during Covid-19 Lockdown. Students with the most creative artwork are featured in SAF Annual Calendar 2021.

SAF Schools Re-open:

As schools resumed post lockdown across Pakistan, SAF school student joined back with vigor and zeal. Students were given an orientation on Covid-19 protocols, and were provided hygiene awareness, face masks and hand sanitizers. A huge dropout rate was observed in the female population of the schools. An intervention entailing community awareness has been initiated to enroll out of school girls.

Provision of Uniform:

As part of SAF education initiative all students enrolled at SAF schools are provided uniforms, sweaters, shoes and socks at the start of each term. SAF Rehri Goth Campus is adopted by Lucky Cement, where students are provided uniforms with their support.

Access to Education:

Unity Grammar joins SAF Australia on its mission to make out-of-school children the future shining stars. Unity Grammar pledged to adopt 40 students and pay for their monthly educational expenses. This partnership will allow student to continue their education without worrying about their tuition fee.



Tipu Sharif Visit to School:

Veteran TV actor and singer, Tipu Sharif, visited our Shahid Afridi Foundation School in Rehri Goth, Karachi. He spent a day with students, interacting and sharing his life experiences with them.



WATER

Hand Pumps Installation:

Water connects every aspect of life. Access to water can turn problems into potential – empowering people with time for school and work, and contributing to improved health for women, children, and families. SAF has brought access to water to over 25,000 households across Pakistan through its various projects this quarter:

- 📍 Installation of 50 hand pumps on the outskirts of Bahawalpur, Punjab.
- 📍 Installation of 5 hand pumps in Tando Allahyar District, Sindh, catering to 4,000 households.
- 📍 400 Residents of Tarkha Koi Muhalla, Sangra Karak, Tirah Valley can easily access water near their homes with the installation of a hand pump.



- 📍 A pipeline of 5,000ft. laid down in Singas, and another 6000ft. pipeline in Adamkhel, Tirah Valley is providing water to 2,400 individuals with 6,840 gallons of water.
- 📍 6000ft. pipeline is laid down in Bar Qamber khel, Narhao Khel, KPK benefitting 1,000 households.
- 📍 9 hand pumps were installed in Mirpur Khas and adjoining areas facilitating various communities of the city.

EMERGENCY RELIEF RESPONSE

Various impoverished families are struggling to establish financial security through a stable income stream due to the unemployment caused by COVID-19. This is their first winter living in freezing-cold temporary shelters, especially the population that is at high risk i.e. very young and very old age. SAF has provided warm clothes to 200 daily wagers and street hawkers in Peshawar, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
