SAF integrates its core strengths into programs shaped to assist deprived communities as they make the journey from relief to self-reliance. For that, SAF has helped strengthen communities and set them up to withstand challenges such as Food insecurity, Healthcare, Education, Water Supply, and Sports as a spectrum of development with equal opportunities to achieve sustainability. This quarter our journey of Hope reached destitute communities in Sindh through Food Security drives and community water tanks. We facilitated the youth of Baluchistan through provision of Sport gear and kits at the Pishin Cricket Academy.

To continue our journey of Hope, we initiated a campaign Building Dreams Fundraiser USA Tour 2021. Building Dreams is an invitation to offer lasting HOPE - a new chapter of compassion for the families living on the margins in our community giving them a chance to make their DREAMS come true.

To support this cause, squash legend and SAF Trustee Jahangir Khan, critically acclaimed actor and SAF advocate Adnan Siddiqui, and I took on an enriching yet a rewarding trip to USA across 11 states in 12 days. The trip was planned for the core purpose of spreading awareness and raising funds to invest in the future of underprivileged children by helping them enroll back to school, and to empower struggling communities to access clean water in Baluchistan.

Our mission of ensuring Hope Not Out is getting bigger and better; we pledge to continue this journey and ensure Hope stays Not Out!

The increasing complexity of social and economic issues with the addition of coronavirus has further burdened funding streams. The impact of the Covid-19 has tested our collective resilience and will continue to do so. At Shahid Afridi Foundation, we remain steadfast in our commitment to remain a constant source of support for the underprivileged.

Continuing our endeavor to reach the most destitute families, Building Dreams USA Tour 2021 was planned. The tour was led by the Chairman Shahid Afridi, he was joined by Jahangir Khan SAF Trustee and actor Adnan Siddiqui. The team visited 11 states through the 12-day tour to raise awareness and funds to help enroll out of school children and to bring access to water for struggling families in Baluchistan.

The tour was an absolute success with the team reaching their fundraising targets, with the support of our friends and supporters we will be able to enroll another **800 students** at SAF schools and bring access to water to over **4,000 households** across Baluchistan.

Bringing Access to Water: With support of our USA Chapter donors, SAF has installed water pumps in **4 communities** of Tando Jan Mohammad, and Mirpurkhas in its efforts to overcome water poverty with safe water source and have sustainable solution for the community.

AUSTRALIA

• **Access to Water:** SAF currently brings safe water to Jhuluri village, Belaro village, Kot Ghulam village, and Manor Kot Ghulam Mohammad village, Sindh by building **2 community water tanks** powered by solar energy, and **03 hand pumps**. We are grateful to our donors Mr. Kaleem Khan & Mr. Arsalan Naseem for joining hands with us to make access to water possible for the residents by sponsoring solar powered water tanks.

SAF was able to reach the beneficiaries with the support of its Australia chapter donors, to solidify long-lasting solutions to ensure water supply is easily accessible in these under-served communities in remote and rural areas over the long term.

• **SAF Arkanabad Campus Adopted by SAF Australia:** SAF Arkanabad School Campus has been adopted by SAF Australia where **236 students** are getting their education. SAF Australia has become the beacon of hope for the students enrolled in the school. Our donors are ensuring every child is prepared to learn and succeed in the classroom by providing them school supplies including uniform and curricula free of cost. The interventions in the school also include construction of a library and an IT Lab. We are grateful to our valued donors Ms. Huma Ali & family and Mr. Shah & family for sponsoring the Library & IT Lab.

• **Sponsoring Computers for Girls STEM Education:** STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) learning is important for students in their everyday life in this contemporary world, with the rise of new technologies in biomedicine, microfabrication, robotics, and artificial intelligence. **SAF Australia Youth Ambassador, Daniya Syed** raised funds to support STEM Education for underprivileged girls at Arkanabad School, Karachi to provide access to technologies (i.e., computers) for **15 students**. This will enable the integration of digital learning which allows the SAF School students to come at par with the world.



UNITED KINGDOM 

• **Collaboration with Mama Trust:** Furthering our efforts of Food Security we reached Kala Khail, Tailabund, Owermar, and Zangalay in KP. The food security drive facilitated over **1,000 households** with ration and provided wheelchairs to families with special need persons. Mama Trust supported our efforts of ensuring Hope – Not Out for the families living in remote regions of KP.

• **Food Bank:** Envisioning a future without food insecurity, SAF UK has initiated a campaign to reach out to the homeless and most vulnerable households living in Croydon, South London. Under the hot meal drive, SAF's team of volunteers deliver free food for the homeless in collaboration with Night Watch, to build resilience and improve nutrition. This initiative is part of SAF's global food security campaign meeting United Nations; Sustainable Development Goal 2 No Hunger.



• **SAF vs Loughton:** A charity cricket match took place in Loughton, Essex where SAF was kindly hosted by Loughton CC. The SAF squad included Pakistan Test Cricketer **Yasir Arafat**. Both the teams put on an event raising funds for our projects helping underserved communities in Pakistan. The match was a reminder of the power of cricket, and what can be achieved when it galvanizes all its forces. The match was **won by SAF team** and was thoroughly enjoyed by supporters, locals, and families.

• **Dragon Boat Race:** The SAF UK team participated in the Al-Noor Dragon Boat Race, with entries in both women's and men's teams. The teams successfully competed against a host of other charities, all raising funds for their respective causes in keeping the organization more sustainable. Through this endeavor SAF was able to raise awareness about its initiatives at large and create a new pool of donors.

EMERGENCY RELIEF RESPONSE

• **Food Security Campaign:** Food insecurity can have detrimental effects on those who experience it and more people around the country are going hungry now than before the pandemic hit. Therefore, SAF had to pivot from providing other essential services to offering the most essential service of all: giving food. It has been at the forefront in combating the problem of hunger through its ration drives reaching impoverished communities of Sindh. The SAF food security campaign has reached **1,485 households** across Sindh in this quarter to help families overcome malnutrition and



access nutritional food. SAF collaborated with Muslims in Need, and Nazir Awan Foundation to carry out successful ration drives with the hope to improve malnourishment rates in respective areas.

• **Provision of Lunch:** Extending food security to SAF education and making it easier for communities to develop healthy eating habits; students at SAF school Wadoodia Muhallah Campus are being provided with lunch **every day at** school. Lunchboxes offered by SAF include meals that are high in nutritional value to promote better dietary habits and reduce burden from parents in the community who must provide lunch to their children daily. The activity is wholeheartedly supported by **SAF UK chapter** and their generous donor **Regal Food**.

HEALTH

• **COVID-19 Vaccination:** Under SAF health initiative, we have initiated the process of COVID 19 vaccination through our **Mother Child Health Promotion Center**, our collaborating partner **PACHAAN** with the support of Government of Pakistan ensured COVID-19 vaccination is available for underserved community of Malikpur, Lahore where SAF interventions through SAF School and a maternal clinic is making an impact at large.



• **Immunization against Hepatitis:** Advancing Sustainable Development Goals set out by United Nations & Govt. of Pakistan against Hepatitis for children, an immunization drive was organized at SAF school Malikpur campus and **Mother Child Health Promotion Center** with the support of **PAHCHAAN**. SAF health vision believes vaccines go hand in hand with good nutrition to help reduce child mortality by preventing children from tipping into a state of malnourishment and enabling the proper absorption of essential nutrients in their bodies.



EDUCATION

• **Celebration of young minds through SAF Education:** SAF arranged an academic ceremonies to honor all hardworking students across a network of 14 SAF schools as they got promoted to the next grade, to further encourage the students to improve their performance because **happier students = happier teacher = happier school**.



INTERVENTIONS AT LUCKY CEMENT CAMPUS:

This quarter we completed our first year of partnership with Lucky Cement, we are so indebted to have them as our education partner. Their support have enabled our journey of Hope to reach new heights. With the support of Lucky Cement we were able to become a beacon of hope for the community of Rehri Goth through various interventions.

• **Bringing access to Education:** Continuing to support SAF's mission to building future, curriculum books and stationery were provided to the students of Lucky Cement Campus Rehri Goth as they started their new academic year.

Academic Ceremony at Lucky Cement Campus – Rehri Goth: Lucky Cement CSR team visited SAF Lucky Cement Campus at Rehri Goth for an engaging academic ceremony. Students being promoted to the next grade were given certificates and medals along with the encouragement to continue their journey of seeking knowledge. The CSR team representatives engaged with the students motivating them how education can help them move forward, sharing their own life stories

Mini MBA program to promote entrepreneurial development: SAF held the third Group Workshop with graduates of Mini MBA program at SAF Lucky Cement Campus, Rehri Goth, to promote entrepreneurial development to stimulate the national economy. The participants shared their experiences, challenges, and opportunities for expanding their business as well as how they plan to work towards establishing sustainable plans to grow their current business.

Baskin Robbins and SAF join hands working together to promote quality education:

Female students from **Pepri Nazeerabad campus & Lucky Cement campus Rehri Goth** took part in capacity building & social development activities in which their social skills were developed over some delicious ice cream, under SAF education initiative of **تعلیم ہو گی عوام، ہر بیٹی کے نام!** The activity was planned in collaboration with Baskin Robbins under their campaign **Spreading Happiness**, the initiative is working towards empowering women by equipping them with necessary social skills.

Independence Day Celebrations: This Independence Day was celebrated with great zeal and enthusiasm across **14 SAF schools**, the students learned the importance of freedom and how our forefathers worked to ensure we have an independent state and how we should work together to protect the sovereignty of the country.

As part of the Independence Day celebrations, Baskin Robbins celebrated Azadi with the students from one of the SAF schools in Malikpur Lahore, by distributing cookies to them under their **Baantey Khushiyan campaign**. Together with SAF, they encouraged and motivated the future leaders to benefit from the wealth of knowledge. The young stars had the time of their lives in their patriotic gear as they learned about the significance of Independence, sacrifices made by our founding fathers and the true spirit of being a Pakistani.



SAF School in Tirah Valley: The construction of the first purpose-built school in Tirah Valley's construction began in 2018 is now near completion with the roof installed and whitewash of the school in process, the school will be functional by next academic year. Under SAF Education initiative, we aim to make this an educational hub for the community of Tirah where students can develop vocational skills, teachers can go through professional development & the community is involved through capacity building & social development projects.



Imparting Entrepreneurial Skills: SAF education does not only focuses on academic development of our students but also towards their professional growth. We want our students to become role models within their community and to pave way for economic growth. For this SAF has collaborated with **LUMS Entrepreneurial Society (LES)** towards equipping youth with the tools to secure brighter prospects for their communities to impart instrumental professional skills to the students of all 14 SAF schools.

WATER

• **Access to safe water at Partak Upper Dir:** Over **16 million** suffer each day from scarce and contaminated water in Pakistan. SAF has been moving the needle on the issue, while its campaigns are shedding light on the need for clean water and restore hope throughout the country. To bring access to clean water, SAF is constructing a **Hydro Power Plant** for the communities of **Patak, Upper Dir**, to enrich the lives of locals in the area who have limited or no ready access to water.

• **Drinking Water Schemes:** Improved access to safe water in adequate quantities can enhance health, enrolment in educational programs, economic productivity, and dignity. It thus plays a key role in efforts to reduce poverty – another SDG target is being met with the construction of a filtration plant in Samo Goth, Gadap Town. The filtration will be functional by the next quarter, benefitting **500 households** of the community.

SPORTS REHABILITATION

• **Hope – Not Out with PCB:** For the second term **PCB** has joined hands with SAF as official charity partner to work collectively to uplift underserved communities across the country by representing SAF logo on Pakistan team kit. The collaboration will help raise awareness about SAF initiatives and to move forward from good to great. The partnership represents the sustainable development goal 16 given with United Nations promoting social development and peace through sports.



• **SAF and Rawalakot Hawks join hands to become social welfare partners:** With great zeal, SAF is proud to be the social welfare partner of Rawalakot Hawks in the first edition of Kashmir premier league. The logo on the team kit represents how SAF is working to uplift underserved communities and ensuring the journey of hope continues.

• **Pishin Cricket Academy partners with SAF in its sports mission:** Taking SAF sports mission a step forward, SAF joined hands with Pishin Cricket Academy and distributed sports gear to promote athletic development and motivate aspiring cricket stars to spread Hope in the area as a tribute to our Nation and celebrate In-
