I am proud to inform **SAF** is on the mission to build 500 houses, where we have built 85 houses in Sindh and Baluchistan. With the support of our diaspora community, we have raised the required funds through our fundraisers in Australia and United Kingdom. Like always I am grateful for their support for joining our cause.

REHABILITATING DREAMS FOR THE FLOOD AFFECTEES

SAF's flood relief campaign has provided significant aid to affected households, with the support of Rehabilitating Dreams USA Tour 2022 donors:

- **75 homes** for flood-affected families in Mastung, Balochistan have been provided
- **35 Brick-and-mortar homes**, currently under construction.
- **A Mother and Child Mobile Health Unit has been made operational** in Quetta reaching out to the families 300 KM radius in the adjoining areas.
- Monthly ration packages, winterization kits and life essentials provided to **300 families each month**.



ACCESS TO WATER

- 29 hand pumps across 29 villages in Sindh.
- 2 community water tanks were installed in Naushero Feroz, Sindh.

These interventions have ensured access to safe water and sanitation for 1,000+ households.



SUPPORTING THE UNDERSERVED THROUGH COOKED MEALS

Team SAF Australia prepared 120 meals for the homeless community in Sydney reaching out to refugees, homeless and vulnerable families.



EXTENDING A HELPING HAND FOR TURKIYE EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS

To reach out to the victims of Turkiye Earthquake, SAF Australia joined hands with the Human Appeal to support affected families to survive the harsh weather.

SYDNEY

The Night of Hope, Sydney was held on 19th March and was attended by dignitaries; Mr. Muhammad Ashraf (Consul General of Pakistan in Sydney), Mr. Aman Singh (Australian of the Year) The event was a full house and raised funds to support the rehabilitation of flood affected in Pakistan.



MELBOURNE

The Night of Melbourne was held on 25th March. A monthly foodbank is organized to feed 200 homeless families in Croydon, London. The food drive is creating food security in the area. The foodbank caters to all ethnicities and religious minorities without any discrimination.



SAF UK STUDENT NETWORK ON THE FRONTLINES FOR THE FLOOD AFFECTEES

SAF UK Student Network joined forces to rehabilitate the flood affected across Pakistan. This quarter, the **Pakistan Society of Brunel University** sold goodie bags to raise much needed funds.



HOMES FOR THE FLOOD AFFECTEES THROUGH WORLD CARE FOUNDATION

SAF UK raised funds with World Care Foundation through a series of fundraisers to help the flood victims in Mirpurkhas, Sindh. With the target of reaching 100 families in the area; this quarter 20 homes have been constructed and handed over and another 20 are under construction.



SUPPORTING THE EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS IN TURKIYE: PROVIDING ESSENTIAL AID!

SAF UK and World Care Foundation partnered to provide cooked meals to earthquake victims at shelter camps in Turkiye. 2 cooked meals were provided to help ease the pain of the struggling victims and give them warmth to get through this difficult time.

SAF SINGAPORE

WINTERIZATION AND HYGIENE KITS THROUGH DONORS IN SINGAPORE.

Our team in Singapore raised funds and collected items to be provided to flood victims, **120 blankets for children and 100+ Hygiene kits for women.** The blankets were distributed in Walidad Goth, Gadap, whereas, the hygiene kits were distributed to women in Balochistan.

EMERGENCY RELIEF RESPONSE

FLOODS IN PAKISTAN BENEFITTED 26,000 HHS

In response to the challenges brought by floods, SAF has intensified its efforts to provide assistance to those in need. In this quarter, we have provided:

- Rations to over 16,000 flood affected households.
- Distributed winterization kits to 500 households.



PARTNERSHIP WITH IDRF CANADA TO FACILITATE THE FLOOD AFFECTEES

SAF partnered with IDRF Canada to provide rations for 6,000 households in 24 locations across Sindh and Balochistan Province. The partnership aimed to ensure food security for the flood affectees.



HUMANITI AND IDRF COLLABORATION FOR FOOD SECURITY

SAF continued to collaborate with Humaniti and IDRF to ensure Food Security in Sindh. The project aimed to provide consistent supplies of healthy dietary items to **500 households in Sindh Province.**

VISIT OF CANADIAN MP SALMA ZAHID

SAF was honored to receive a visit from Canadian MP Salma Zahid, who took the time to witness the impact of the organization's Emergency Relief Response, Health, and Education initiatives in Pakistan.

She visited SAF's school campus in Arkanabad to observe the difference SAF education is making. The visit also included Ration Drives with the SAF team in Gharo and Hyderabad, Sindh, where Ms. Zahid helped distribute food supplies to 400+ households in need. She also visited to SAF's Mobile Health Unit in Chakwal to observe the health care services provided.



TEAM HUMANITI CANADA VISITS SAF INITIATIVES

Team Humaniti visited SAF's initiatives in Pakistan to assess their impact on the local community.

- The team visited the SAF School Campus in Arkanabad, where they observed the educational programs being implemented.
- Participated in a ration drive organized by SAF in Gharo, Sindh, to provide much-needed assistance to the underserved community.



JOINING HANDS FOR A BETTER TOMORROW



BANK ALFALAH

The collaboration with Bank Alfalah:

- Equipped **600 farmers** with the resources for continuous sustenance
- Provided **1620 affectees** with Winterization Kits, and rations to affected households across Balochistan.
- **400 households** were facilitated with rations in Afghan Refugee Camp in Karachi.



MEIJI PAKISTAN

To ensure access to proper nutrition for the children who have been suffering with malnutrition due to shortage in food supplies due to floods Meiji Pakistan provided **powdered milk for 300+ children in flood-affected areas** in Sindh and Balochistan.

SUPPORTING THE TURKIYE EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS

SAF extended its support to the earthquake victims in Turkiye by collaborating with Meiji Pakistan and Baitussalam Welfare Trust. The organization donated relief equipment to the affectees and aimed to provide them with hope and assistance during challenging times.



SAF EDUCATION



ENSURING ATTIRE FOR SUCCESS:

200 uniforms were distributed to students at the SAF School Shahina Parveen Campus in Arkanabad, Karachi supported by Habib Oil Mills. This effort aims to remove any potential barriers to education and enable students to embark on their educational journey with confidence.



EMPOWERING EDUCATION THROUGH A NEW LIBRARY:

Addition of a new library at the SAF School Lucky Cement, Rehri Goth Campus - this facility will offer opportunities for learning, promote literacy, and support the growth of new ideas and perspectives that will equip students to thrive beyond the school walls.

EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES THROUGH COLLABORATION:

Baskin Robbins and SAF is continuing their partnership with for the fourth time for our education initiative **“Taleem Hogi Aam – Har Beti Kay Naam”**. The partnership supports **150 female students at SAF Schools**. This year Mentorship and Internship programs are introduced by Baskin Robins that will allow graduating students to gain practical and professional skills and deeper learning experiences, further advancing SAF’s education plans.



FOSTERING ENTREPRENEURIAL PROGRESS:

Peace Through Prosperity and SAF have organized another series of Mini MBA workshops for 31 parents at Lucky Cement Rehri Goth, Bhangoria, and Arkanabad campuses. These workshops are designed to support the progress of previous sessions where lessons on budgeting and investing in new business ventures is revised.



EMPOWERING YOUTH THROUGH ENTREPRENEURSHIP:

A six-week **Social Outreach Program** with the Entrepreneurial Society at LUMS for students at the SAF School Malikpur Campus in Lahore was planned **where 70 students** participated in the program, which aimed to help them unlock their potential and create value in society through entrepreneurship.



SAF HEALTH



MOBILE HEALTH UNITS

The SAF Mobile Health Units are operational in Chakwal and Quetta, reaching areas where mothers and children have limited access to medical care.

Chakwal 9,000 These units have already served over 9,000 beneficiaries in Chakwal and 600 in Quetta and their peripheries, making a significant impact on the health and well-being of these communities.



MEDICAL CAMP AT TIRAH

Expanding access to healthcare in remote regions. SAF organized a two-day medical camp for children in Tirah, offering free medicine and OPD services to the surrounding communities. This initiative demonstrates our commitment to reaching communities in need and providing them with vital medical care.

CHARITY PARTNERSHIP FOR HOPE IN BALOCHISTAN:

Harnessing the power of sports to make a difference. SAF was honored to be chosen as the charity partner for the exhibition match between Quetta Gladiators and Peshawar Zalmi match in Quetta, promoting the message of "Hope Not Out" for Balochistan.
